

CELERION ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Celerion has risk mitigation procedures in place to reduce the potential spread of illness at our facility. Visitors are encouraged to stay home if they are feeling unwell. Before arriving for a visit, please refer to the CDC website on the signs and symptoms of COVID-19. If you have experienced these symptoms in the last 14 days, please re-schedule your visit.

UPON ARRIVAL AT CELERION

All visitors arriving at Celerion must complete a digital temperature scan prior to entry. Upon arrival, please proceed to the reception area to complete these check-in procedures.



DURING YOUR VISIT (MONITORING AND CONFERENCE ROOMS)

Visitors are encouraged to practice frequent hand hygiene during a visit at Celerion. Conference rooms are cleaned and disinfected after each visit. Additional cleaning supplies are available upon request.

Please maintain social distancing as much as possible. Face to face interactions should be managed at a safe distance and masks should be worn at all times when in public areas.



PRIOR TO ENTERING THE CPU

Our first priority is to keep participants and staff healthy as we navigate through the COVID-19 Pandemic. Although our culture has always been to encourage sponsors to visit the CPU and observe conduct, in the early phase of our COVID-19 risk mitigation plan, we must re-think this approach. We ask that sponsors consider whether face to face visits are necessary, or if alternate arrangements can be made to ensure conduct oversight.

If a visit is considered business critical, visitors are allowed to enter the CPU, Pharmacy or Clinical Laboratory for conduct observation. These visits must be arranged in advance. Prior to entry to the CPU/Pharmacy/Clinical Laboratory, **visitors must complete a COVID-19 PCR test**. Celerion can provide this testing onsite. Individuals with a positive result for COVID-19 will be asked to leave the facility and follow up with their PCP for further guidance.

At all times during face to face interactions with Celerion personnel, **masks must be worn**. Shoes must be cleaned or shoe covers donned prior to entering the CPU. Celerion personnel hosting the visit will provide these PPE supplies.



VIRTUAL CONDUCT OBSERVATION

As a reminder, Celerion offers Celexus access to all sponsors. This allows real-time awareness of data collection activities virtually. We would encourage sponsors to discuss the use of Celexus or other virtual conduct observation options in lieu of onsite conduct visits.
